INFORMATION

- All events take place at the Midmar Dam resort (exit 103 or 107 from N3 highway)
- GPS co-ordinates -29.48882 30.19397
- No entry fees will be refunded under any circumstances
- All events start and finish at the main slipway
- Tog bag facility will be provided but at owners risk
- Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by the National Insurance policy

- Participants 70 years old and over entry fee will be R100 (excludes 5 km fun run). Proof of age may be requested.
- All category and record prize money, will be paid by electronic transfer.
- The 5 km fun run will not be timed

RULES

- All events are subjects to the rules of WA, ASA & KZNA
- Licensed entrants must wear full club colours and licence number on the front and back of vest/crop top
- Your race number must be worn on the front of your vest/ crop top on the top of the ASA licence without covering the year, logo of KZN Athletics and the ASA sponsor
- Unregistered athletes running with temporary licenses must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA Advertising Regulations. Holders of temporary licenses will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim for age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rules.
- All unlicensed entrants require a Temporary Licence Number which must be worn on the back of your vest/crop top with the race number on the front

- Foreign athletes must comply with WA rule CR 1.7, TR 4.1 and TR 4.2 together with ASA rule 9
- **No personal seconding is permitted along the route**
- **No motor vehicles, wheel-chairs, bicycles or dogs are permitted on the route**
- All Traffic Officers, Marshals and Officials must be obeyed
- This is a "litter free" event. Offenders may be removed from the results
- The 42.2 km, 21.1 km and 10 km events are not inter-changeable
- ASA/KZNA approved age category tags must be worn on the front and back of vest/crop top to be eligible for category prizes
- Junior athletes in the 10 km and 21.1 km events must be 19 years or younger on 31 December in the year of competition

PRIZES & HANDOUTS

- Equal prize monies are offered to both Men and Women
- Free t-shirts to the first 800 online entrants in the 10 km, 21.1 km and 42.2 events. T-shirt sizes subject to availability.
- All prize winners must be personally present at the prize giving
- Proof of age may be required to claim age category prizes
- A participant who improves on the course record will receive an additional R1000 in prize money.
- All finishers will be eligible for Lucky Draw Prizes
- The club with the most on-line entrants in the 10 km, 21.1 km and 42.2 km (excluding 5km fun run) will receive a prize of R2500. Second prize R1500.
